<i>Atlas</i>	Q3 2026	The AI travel agent with approval-gated booking, launching this year with Voyager and the production rebuild of Catalogues.
<i>Voyager</i>	Q3 2026	Multi-traveler trip workspace, launching with Atlas. Its versioned trip state is the AI agent's working memory.
<i>Trust SDK</i>	2026	Verifiable transaction infrastructure: signed receipts plus AP2-Travel v0.1, an open standard published under neutral governance.
<i>Catalogues</i>	2024 reLaunch 2026	First creator marketplace: ten operator-vetted creators, 500+ paid guide sales. Rebuilt for production and relaunching alongside Atlas.
